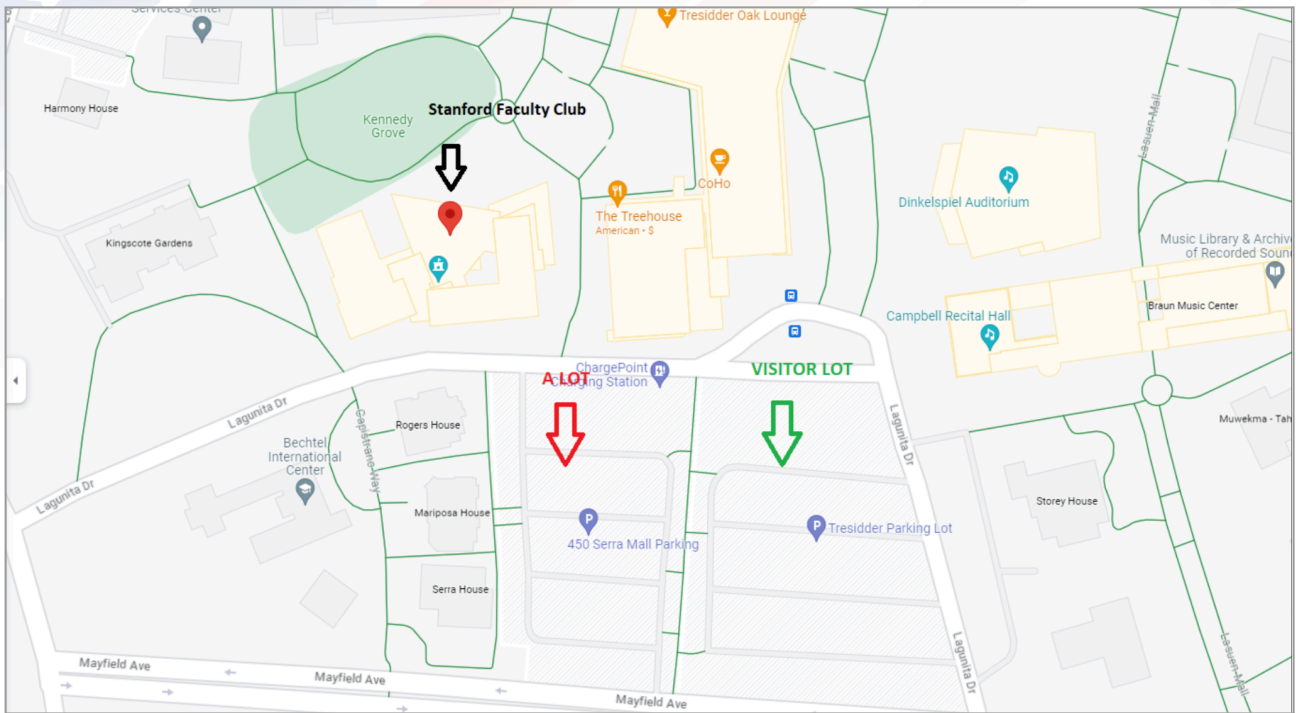
Parking Information

Limited Parking is available at the Stanford Faculty Club. We strongly recommend using Uber or Lyft for travel between your hotel and the Faculty Club.

Bus transportation will be provided from the Stanford Faculty Club to the Neuvera Brain Health Institute (one-way only).

If you choose to drive, Stanford Faculty Club guests must park in the visitor parking lot. Please be sure not to park in the A lot. The two lots are divided by a walkway.

Payment needs to be made through the “Parkmobile” app. You can find the QR codes around the lot.



Airport Information

For guests flying in, San Francisco International Airport (SFO) is the primary gateway to Stanford University and Neuvera Brain Health Institute, located approximately 21–28 miles away which is typically a 30–35 minute drive during normal traffic conditions.

Hotel Information

For guests staying overnight on Thursday, March 19, there are several comfortable and reasonably priced hotels within 3 miles of the Stanford campus. We recommend the following options, which typically offer rates around \$200/night.

- **Sheraton Palo Alto Hotel:** A convenient full-service option located at the entrance to campus.
- **The Zen Hotel:** Offers a peaceful atmosphere with complimentary breakfast and parking.
- **Creekside Inn:** A well-regarded value choice featuring a serene garden setting.
- **The Cardinal Hotel:** A historic boutique hotel in downtown Palo Alto, within walking distance of local dining.
